Get acquainted with three concepts – Finnish, rock, a cappella – before you walk through the doors and you're off to a fun start. This 70 minute rock concert is Eurovision-esque in the best possible way. With rave reviews from mainly Scandinavian audiences thus far it would be fair to presume at least a little of the quartets performance would be lost in translation, but any little language mishaps only add to their charm.

Jonte, Kasper, Mia and Anna present us with a cappella renditions of our favourites – from Gaga to Coldplay – aided by the musical stylings of the 5th group member Gregory. These are people who know how to make fun of themselves and who also certainly know how to sing. Aside from the buckets of sequins and PVC – and the ABBA reminiscent choreography – the singing is spot on. [Cheesy monologues](#) and comedic audience integration might not be everyone's cup of tea but if you're not afraid of a leather-clad man serenading you the end result is thoroughly enjoyable. Any show that receives a standing ovation is definitely worth a look.
